At CTC Academy's Early Enrichment Program, we don't just support development, we unlock potential.

Designed for children 18 months to 3 years, EEP provides a nurturing, play-based environment where children with development delays and disabilities build critical communication, motor, and social skills.

With expert staff, small class sizes, and integrated therapeutic support, every moment is intentional, joyful, and impactful.

## It's Fun!

EEP is where learning meets fun! Building on early intervention, our program supports each child's social, physical, communication, and cognitive growth in a warm, small-group classroom with individualized support.

Children enjoy circle time, music, stories, play, arts and crafts, yoga, and movement activities—all thoughtfully designed to build confidence and independence. Therapeutic supports, including swings, therapy balls, and obstacle courses, are integrated throughout the day.

With access to an adaptive playground and gym, children develop important social and communication skills in a nurturing, engaging environment.



## Our Professional Staff

Each class is led by a certified special education teacher and supported by a highly trained team.

Our School Social Worker partners with families to guide the transition from early intervention to preschool, while additional offerings, such as parent workshops and sibling support groups, provide meaningful support for the entire family.
